

Rosa's Spanish Picnic: El Picnic de Rosa

Learning objective: To identify and categorise Spanish food vocabulary and express preferences using basic phrases.

Rosa the parrot is packing a basket for a picnic. Help her organise the items by matching the Spanish word to the correct English translation, then use the sentence starters to write about what Rosa is packing.

Word bank: la manzana · el queso · el pan · la leche · el pescado · la ensalada · me gusta · no me gusta

1. Match the Spanish word to its English translation: 1. El pan, 2. La manzana, 3. El pescado, 4. La leche. (4 marks)

2. If Rosa says 'Me gusta la ensalada', does she like or dislike the salad? Explain how you know. (2 marks)

3. Rosa wants to pack cheese. Write the Spanish phrase for 'the cheese'. (1 mark)

4. Write a sentence in Spanish saying what you like to eat from the word bank (e.g., 'Me gusta...'). (2 marks)

5. Write a sentence in Spanish saying what you do not like to eat from the word bank (e.g., 'No me gusta...'). (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picnic blanket with four items from the word bank. Label each item in Spanish using the correct article (el or la).



Extension challenge: Imagine you are inviting a friend to the picnic. Write a short invitation in English, but include three Spanish food words you have learned today.
