

Rosa's Spanish Picnic

Learning objective: To identify and use Spanish vocabulary for common food items and build a descriptive sentence.

Help Rosa the parrot pack her picnic basket! Read the words in the word bank and draw those items inside the basket. Then, label your drawings in Spanish and answer the questions below to describe what you have drawn.

Draw: Draw a large, woven picnic basket in the centre of the page. Inside the basket, illustrate at least four different food items from the word bank (an apple, a banana, bread, cheese, an orange, water, or grapes). Use clear, colourful lines. Next to each item, write the correct Spanish label from the word bank. Add a small drawing of Rosa the parrot sitting on the handle of the basket looking happy.



Label words: la manzana · el plátano · el pan · el queso · la naranja · el agua · la uva

Steps:

1. Draw three of the items from the word bank inside the picnic basket and label them in Spanish.
2. Which item from your drawing is your favourite? Write the Spanish word for it.
3. If a piece of fruit costs £0.50, how much would two pieces cost? Write your answer in Australian dollars and cents.

4. Translate the phrase 'I like the apple' into Spanish using the word bank.
5. Draw a drink in your basket and label it using the word bank.
