

¡Hola, Amigos! Let's Learn Spanish Greetings

Step into the world of Rosa the parrot and discover how to say hello in Spanish!

- When the sun is high in the sky after lunch, we use 'Buenas tardes' to say good afternoon.
- We use 'Buenos días' specifically in the morning, usually before midday.
- 'Buenas noches' is used both as a greeting when arriving in the evening and as a way to say goodnight before sleep.
- 'Hola' is a versatile, informal greeting that you can use at any time of day with friends.
- If someone asks '¿Cómo estás?', a polite way to reply is 'Bien, gracias', which means 'I am fine, thank you'.

Did you know? Did you know? In Spanish-speaking countries, when people greet each other, they often use a 'beso' (a light kiss on the cheek) or a firm handshake. It is a very friendly and warm way to show respect to your friends and family!
