

Spanish Greetings with Rosa the Parrot

Learning objective: To learn, recognise, and correctly apply common Spanish greetings and introductory phrases.

Rosa the Parrot is ready to help you practise your Spanish! Read each question carefully and use your knowledge of greetings to complete the tasks below.

Word bank: Hola · Buenos días · Buenas tardes · Buenas noches · ¿Cómo estás? · Bien, gracias · Adiós · Hasta luego

1. Rosa meets a friend at 9:00 in the morning. Write the Spanish greeting she should use to say 'Good morning'. (1 mark)

2. If someone asks you '¿Cómo estás?', what are two different ways you could respond in Spanish? Write them below. (2 marks)

3. You are leaving school at 3:30 in the afternoon. Which two phrases from the word bank could you use to say goodbye to your teacher? (2 marks)

4. Match the time of day to the correct greeting: 1. Midday (1:00 PM), 2. Night-time (9:00 PM). (2 marks)

5. Rosa is writing a letter to a friend. How would she start the letter with a friendly 'Hello' and end it with 'See you later'? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Rosa the Parrot wearing a colourful scarf, perched on a branch, greeting a group of her animal friends in a sunny forest.
