

Rosa's Hobbies Art Gallery

Learning objective: To identify and use Spanish vocabulary for hobbies and present them creatively through illustration.

Rosa the parrot wants to create an art gallery of her friends' favourite hobbies. Use the word bank to label your drawings in Spanish. Make sure your illustrations are colourful and detailed!

Draw: Create a vibrant, multi-panel scene on A4 paper. Divide your page into four distinct sections. In each section, illustrate a character engaged in a specific hobby. Use bright, primary colours. Ensure the characters are expressive—for example, a character 'nadar' should be shown with water ripples, while 'dibujar' should show a sketchbook with a colourful picture inside. Keep the style neat and artistic, suitable for an 'Art Gallery' theme.



Label words: leer (to read) · jugar al fútbol (to play football) · nadar (to swim) · dibujar (to draw) · escuchar música (to listen to music) · montar en bicicleta (to ride a bike)

Steps:

1. Step 1: Choose three hobbies from the word bank. Draw a character performing each hobby in a different corner of your page.
2. Step 2: Label each of your three drawings with the correct Spanish phrase from the word bank.
3. Explain why you think it is important to have a variety of hobbies in your spare time.

4. Compare and contrast 'nadar' and 'montar en bicicleta'. Which one requires more equipment? Justify your answer.
5. What might happen if someone only had one hobby for their entire life? Explore the potential impact on their skills.
6. Create a new Spanish phrase for a hobby not in our list (you may need to research or use a dictionary) and draw it in the centre of your page.
