Answer Key: 1.C, 2.True, 3.Leer, 4.B, 5.False, 6.Nadar, 7.A, 8.True, 9.Dibujar, 10.B. Note to teacher: Ensure students have understood the difference between 'me gusta' (I like) and 'no me gusta' (I do not like).
