

Year 4 Spanish Assessment: Los Meses del Año

Learning objective: To recall, identify, and use the months of the year in Spanish correctly.

Read each question carefully and write your answers in the space provided. Rosa the parrot is here to help you remember your vocabulary!

Rosa the parrot is busy planning her calendar for the year. She loves to celebrate the changing seasons and needs to make sure she has her Spanish months in the right order to keep her travel plans organised.

Word bank: enero · febrero · marzo · abril · mayo · junio · julio · agosto · septiembre · octubre · noviembre · diciembre

1. Write the Spanish word for the first month of the year (January) and the last month of the year (December). (2 marks)

2. Which month comes immediately after 'marzo'? Write your answer in Spanish. (2 marks)

3. If Rosa's birthday is in the month of 'agosto', what is the English name for that month? (2 marks)

4. Rosa is planning a trip. She says, 'Mi viaje es en junio.' Translate this sentence into English. (3 marks)

5. List the three months that make up the Spanish summer season (junio, julio, agosto) and explain why these months are important to Rosa the parrot. (4 marks)

6. Rosa wants to write a short poem about her favourite time of year. Write a paragraph of 4-5 sentences in English explaining which month is your favourite and why, including the Spanish name for that month in your writing. (5 marks)

7. Match the following months to their correct order by numbering them 1 to 4: (A) mayo, (B) enero, (C) marzo, (D) abril. (4 marks)

8. Write a sentence in Spanish saying: 'My birthday is in...' (Mi cumpleaños es en...) using a month of your choice. (3 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of a calendar page for your favourite month. Label the month in Spanish at the top and draw one thing that represents that month (e.g., a flower for spring or a snowflake for winter).
