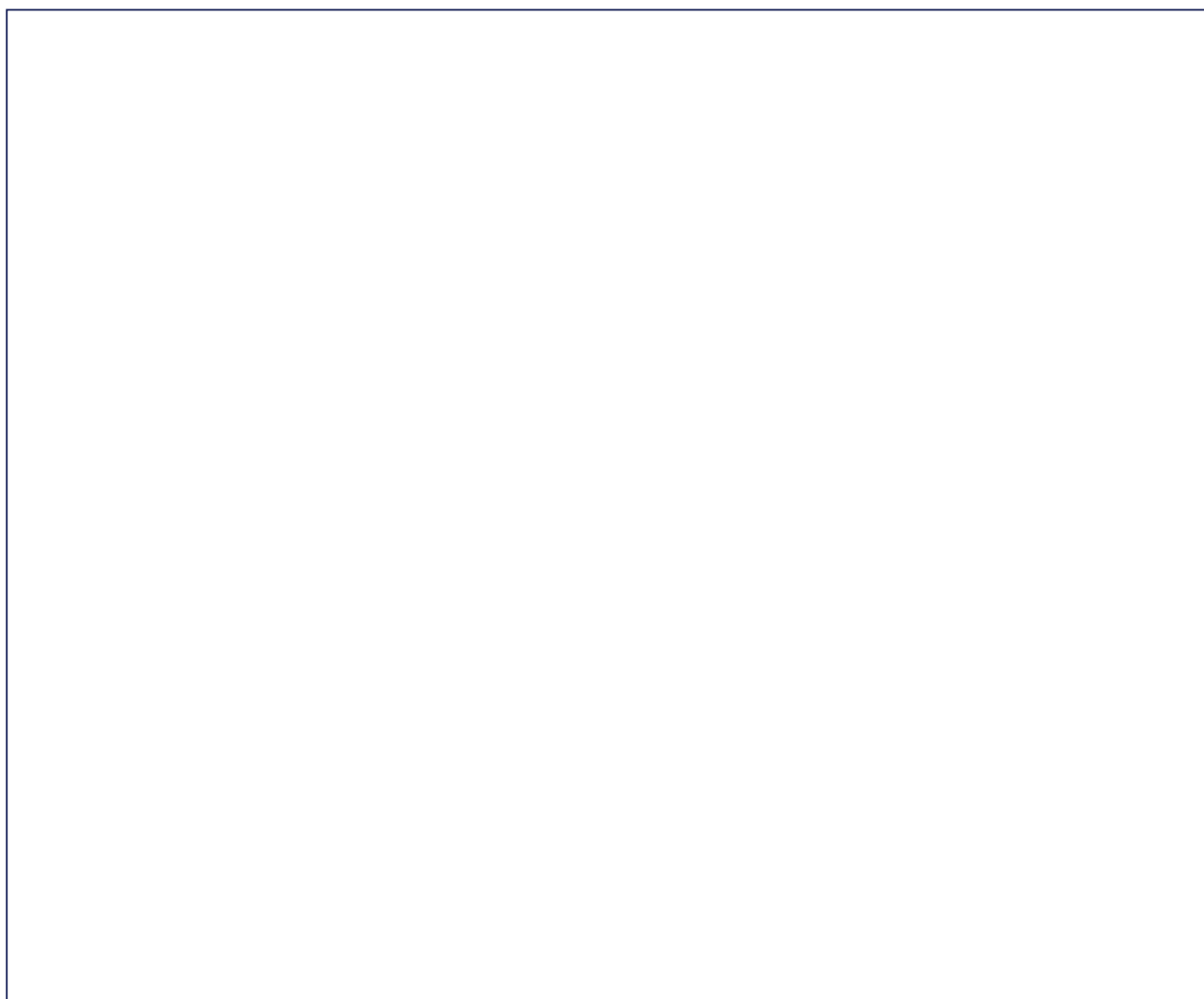


Rosa's Spanish Number Market

Learning objective: To identify and use Spanish numbers from 1 to 20 within the context of a market scene.

Follow the drawing prompt below to create your Spanish market stall. Use your knowledge of Spanish numbers to label the items you have drawn. Remember to write the price in pounds (£) next to each item using the Spanish number word.

Draw: Draw a bustling market stall scene. In the centre, draw Rosa the parrot wearing a small apron, standing behind a wooden counter. On the counter, draw various baskets of fruit. Ensure there is enough space around the fruit to write labels and prices. The style should be bright, colourful, and clean, like a classic storybook illustration.



Label words: uno (1) · cinco (5) · diez (10) · quince (15) · veinte (20) · la fruta · el precio

Steps:

1. Draw 5 apples on your market stall and label them using the Spanish word for five.
2. Draw 10 oranges. Write the price label next to them as '£diez'.
3. Draw 20 grapes. Label them with the Spanish word for twenty.
4. Rosa is buying 15 pears. Draw 15 pears and label them with the correct Spanish number word.
5. If an item costs 'ocho' pounds, write the number 8 in figures next to it.
