

Rosa's Spanish Opinion Workshop

Learning objective: To express likes and dislikes in Spanish using key opinion phrases and justify choices with adjectives.

Rosa the parrot is helping her friends at the school fair! Your task is to complete the opinion grid. First, look at the subject (the item) and the emoji representing the opinion. Write the correct Spanish phrase from the word bank to show how the character feels. Then, add a reason using the adjectives provided to explain your opinion. Example: 'Me gusta el fútbol porque es divertido.'

Word bank: Me gusta (I like) · No me gusta (I do not like) · Me encanta (I love) · Detesto (I detest) · divertido (fun) · aburrido (boring) · fascinante (fascinating) · difícil (difficult)

1. 1. Max is looking at a complex maths puzzle: [Emoji: Heart] 'Me _____ los puzzles porque son _____.' Justify why Max might find this puzzle fascinating rather than difficult. (2 marks)

2. 2. Pip is reading a very long book: [Emoji: Smiley Face] 'Me _____ la lectura porque es _____.' Explain why Pip might choose this phrase over 'Me encanta'. (2 marks)

3. 3. Zara is looking at a blank canvas: [Emoji: Sad Face] 'No me _____ pintar hoy porque es _____.' What might happen if Zara changed her mind and decided to paint something colourful? (2 marks)

4. 4. Compare and contrast the phrases 'Me gusta' and 'Me encanta'. When would a Spanish speaker choose one over the other? (2 marks)

5. 5. If you were describing a rainy day in Spain, which opinion phrase would you use to express your feelings and why? (2 marks)

6. 6. Justify your answer: Is it possible for something to be both 'divertido' and 'difícil' at the same time? Use your knowledge of Spanish opinion phrases to explain. (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a picture of Rosa the parrot hosting a Spanish market stall. Include labels in Spanish for three items on her stall, such as 'la fruta' (fruit) or 'el libro' (book), and add a speech bubble for Rosa using one of the opinion phrases from the word bank.



Extension challenge: Write a short paragraph (3-4 sentences) in Spanish about your favourite hobby. Use at least two different opinion phrases and one adjective to justify your choice. Then, translate your paragraph into English to demonstrate your understanding of the nuances between the phrases.
