

Rosa's Review: My Opinions in Spanish

Learning objective: To express personal opinions in Spanish using a variety of key phrases and justification.

Rosa the parrot wants to know what you think about your favourite things! Use this review template to express your opinions in Spanish. Remember to use a different opinion phrase for each section and provide a reason why using the word 'porque' (because).

Word bank: Me gusta... · No me gusta... · Me encanta... · Odio... · es divertido · es aburrido · es emocionante · porque · muy · un poco

1. Choose a favourite sport or hobby. Write a sentence in Spanish stating your opinion and explaining why, using the word 'porque'. (2 marks)

2. Choose a school subject. Write a sentence in Spanish expressing a negative opinion and justify your choice using 'porque'. (2 marks)

3. Compare your opinions with a friend. Explain why you might have different opinions about the same activity using rich vocabulary. (3 marks)

4. Justify your answer: Why is it important to use different opinion phrases rather than just saying 'Me gusta' for everything? (3 marks)

5. What might happen if you used the phrase 'Me encanta' to describe something you actually find boring? How would this affect communication? (4 marks)

6. Create a new opinion phrase using a dictionary or your own knowledge. Explain how it changes the intensity of your opinion compared to 'Me gusta'. (4 marks)

Extension challenge: Write a short paragraph in Spanish (4-6 sentences) describing your perfect day. Include at least three different opinion phrases and explain why you enjoy each part of your day using 'porque'. Challenge: Can you include one phrase that describes an opinion about the weather?
