5. 5. True or False: 'No me gusta nada' means 'I like it very much'. (1 mark)

6. 6. Fill in the blank: If you really love pizza, you would say '_____ la pizza'. (1 mark)

7. 7. Fill in the blank: If you dislike broccoli, you would say '_____ el brócoli'. (1 mark)

8. 8. Complete the sentence: If you enjoy swimming, you say '_____ nadar'. (1 mark)

9. 9. If you really do not like something, what word do you add to the end of 'No me gusta'? (1 mark)

10. 10. If you like something a lot, what word do you add to the end of 'Me gusta'? (1 mark)
