

¡Vamos de Compras! (Let's Go Shopping!)

Join Rosa the parrot on a shopping adventure! Learn the language of the market and become a confident shopper.

- To ask for the price of an item, we say: '¿Cuánto cuesta?'
- If an item costs £5, you can say: 'Cuesta cinco libras.'
- We use the word 'barato' to describe something that is low in price.
- We use the word 'caro' to describe something that is high in price.
- You can carry your items home in 'la bolsa' (the bag).

Did you know? Did you know? In many Spanish-speaking countries, local markets are the heart of the community. While we use the pound (£) in the UK, many Spanish-speaking countries use different currencies like the Euro (€) or the Peso (\$). Regardless of the currency, the phrase '¿Cuánto cuesta?' is the golden key to finding out the price of your favourite items!
