

Rosa's Spanish Market Adventure

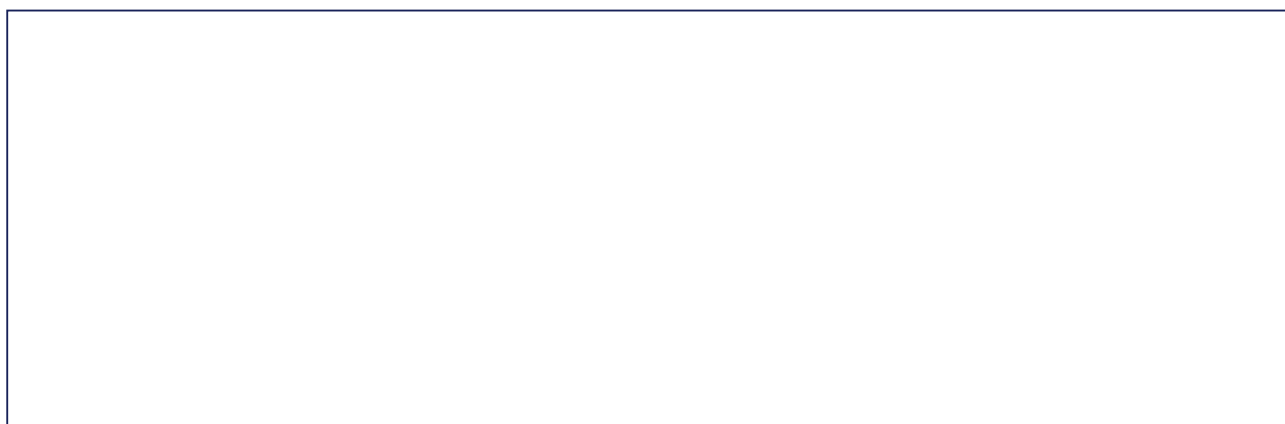
Learning objective: To use Spanish vocabulary for food items and currency to role-play a shopping transaction at a market.

Rosa the parrot is visiting a colourful Spanish street market. Help her complete the shopping list conversation by filling in the blanks. Use the word bank to help you choose the correct Spanish words for the items she wants to buy and the prices she hears.

Word bank: manzanas · pan · dos libras · tres libras · queso · cuesta

1. Rosa asks: '¿Cuánto _____ el pan?' (How much is the bread?) (2 marks)
2. The baker replies: 'El pan cuesta _____.' (The bread costs two pounds.) (2 marks)
3. Rosa wants to buy apples. In Spanish, apples are called _____. (Hint: Look at your word bank!) (2 marks)
4. The shopkeeper says the apples cost £3. Write this in Spanish: 'Las manzanas _____.' (2 marks)
5. Rosa decides to buy some cheese. Translate this phrase: 'I would like the cheese, please.' (2 marks)

Draw: Draw a basket full of the items Rosa bought (bread, apples, and cheese) and label each item with its Spanish name from the word bank.



Extension challenge: Imagine you have a budget of £10. Write a short dialogue in Spanish between you and a shopkeeper where you buy three different items and calculate the total cost in Australian dollars and cents.
