

Rosa's Sports Day Drawing Challenge

Learning objective: To identify and use Spanish vocabulary related to sports and physical activities.

Follow the drawing prompt to create your own Spanish sports scene. Once your picture is complete, label the items using the word bank provided.

Draw: Create a vibrant, busy sports scene on a large sheet of paper. Include a character kicking a football, a swimming pool with someone diving in, and a basketball hoop. Use bright colours and ensure there is enough space around each 'sport' activity to clearly write the Spanish labels from the word bank. Use a clean, cartoon-style illustration technique.



Label words: el fútbol · el tenis · la natación · el baloncesto · la pelota · el atleta

Steps:

1. Draw a character playing 'el fútbol' in the centre of your page.
2. Label the ball in your drawing as 'la pelota'.
3. Draw a swimming pool in the corner and label it 'la natación'.
4. Write a sentence in Spanish describing your favourite sport from the list (e.g., 'Me gusta el tenis').
5. If a football costs £12.50 and a tennis racket costs £15.75, what is the total cost for both?
