

Year 4 Spanish Assessment: Los Transportes (Transport)

Learning objective: To identify and describe different modes of transport in Spanish and express preferences using simple sentence structures.

Read each question carefully. Write your answers in Spanish or English as requested. Use the word bank provided to help you with your spellings.

Rosa the parrot is helping her friends plan their holiday travel. Max wants to go by train because it is fast. Ellie prefers the boat because it is calm. They are all excited to travel across Spain!

Word bank: el coche (car) · el autobús (bus) · el tren (train) · la bicicleta (bicycle) · el avión (aeroplane) · el barco (boat) · rápido (fast) · lento (slow) · me gusta (I like) · no me gusta (I do not like)

1. 1. Using the word bank, write the Spanish name for these three modes of transport: (a) Bicycle, (b) Aeroplane, (c) Bus. (3 marks)

2. 2. If Max says 'El tren es rápido', translate his sentence into English. (2 marks)

3. 3. Which mode of transport would you choose to travel to school? Write a full sentence in Spanish starting with 'Yo voy a la escuela en...' (3 marks)

4. 4. Rosa asks you: '¿Te gusta el coche?' Write a short response in Spanish explaining if you like cars or not, and why (e.g., mention if it is fast or slow). (4 marks)

5. 5. Compare two different modes of transport. Write two sentences in Spanish explaining which one you prefer and why. (Example: 'Me gusta el tren. No me gusta el barco.') (4 marks)

6. 6. Extended Writing Task: Imagine you are going on a holiday with Rosa the parrot. Write 5 sentences in Spanish describing how you will travel and what you will see. You might include: the transport you use, if it is fast or slow, and one thing you see (e.g., the sea, the mountains, the city). (9 marks)
