

Rosa's Transport Travel Journal: Mi Viaje

Learning objective: To use Spanish vocabulary to describe different modes of transport and express personal travel preferences.

Hola! Join Rosa the parrot on a global adventure. Use this travel journal to map out your own journey. Fill in the sections using your Spanish transport vocabulary. Remember to include the correct articles (el/la) and think about why you have chosen your specific mode of transport.

Word bank: el coche (car) · el tren (train) · el autobús (bus) · el avión (aeroplane) · el barco (boat) · la bicicleta (bicycle) · rápido (fast) · lento (slow) · cómodo (comfortable) · divertido (fun)

1. Identify your chosen destination and the mode of transport you will use to get there. Write a full sentence in Spanish explaining your choice. (2 marks)

2. Justify your answer: Why is this mode of transport the most efficient or suitable for your specific journey? Consider the speed and comfort. (3 marks)

3. Compare and contrast: Explain one advantage of travelling by 'el tren' versus 'el coche' in Spanish. (3 marks)

4. Describe the scenery you might see from your window during the journey. Use at least two adjectives in Spanish. (2 marks)

5. What might happen if your chosen mode of transport was suddenly unavailable? How would you change your travel plans? (3 marks)

6. Explain why some people prefer to travel by 'el avión' even if it is more expensive than 'el autobús'. (3 marks)

Extension challenge: Imagine you are designing a brand new, futuristic mode of transport for the year 3000. Create a detailed description of how it works, what it is made of, and name it using a creative Spanish title. Present your invention to the class and explain why it is better than current transport methods.
