

Rosa's Spanish Travel Adventures

Learning objective: To learn and use vocabulary related to modes of transport in Spanish.

Read the passage below about Rosa the parrot's journey around the world. Then, use the word bank to help you answer the questions. Make sure to use your best handwriting!

¡Hola! My name is Rosa, and I love to travel. Last summer, I went on a big trip. First, I went to the airport and caught el avión to visit my friends in Spain. It was very fast! When I arrived, I wanted to see the countryside, so I hopped on el tren. It was a beautiful ride. To get around the city centre, I used el autobús, which only cost £2.50 for a ticket. I even spent a lovely afternoon riding la bicicleta through the park. Finally, I finished my trip by taking el barco across the blue sea. It is so much fun to explore the world!

Word bank: el avión (the aeroplane) · el tren (the train) · el barco (the boat) · el autobús (the bus) · la bicicleta (the bicycle) · viajar (to travel)

1. Which mode of transport did Rosa use to travel to Spain, and what is it called in Spanish? (2 marks)

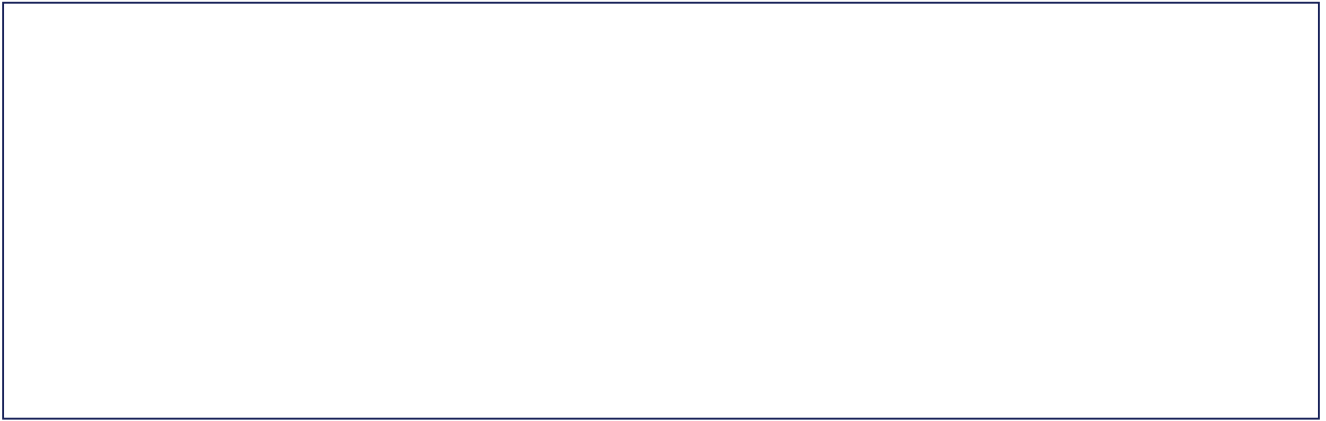
2. If Rosa bought a ticket for the bus (el autobús) that cost £2.50, how much change would she get from a £5.00 note? (2 marks)

3. Find the Spanish word in the text that means 'to travel'. (1 mark)

4. Why does Rosa enjoy using la bicicleta in the park? (2 marks)

5. List two modes of transport from the text that move on water and rails respectively. (2 marks)
