

Rosa's Weather Report: El Tiempo Quiz

Learning objective: To identify and use Spanish vocabulary related to weather conditions in simple sentences, suitable for Year 5 learners.

Join Rosa the parrot as she flies across the world! Read the questions carefully and test your knowledge of Spanish weather phrases.

Answer Key: 1. A, 2. B, 3. True, 4. False, 5. Hace viento, 6. C, 7. True, 8. False, 9. Hace sol, 10. A.

Remember: 'Hace' is used for general weather conditions, while 'Está' describes the state of the clouds.
