

Sheet 3: Short 'i' Words

Worked example:

Sound out the word: p-i-g

Answer: pig

- **Read these words with Pip the bookworm:**

pig big dig wig fig

- **Draw a line to match the word to the picture:**

pig - [picture of a pig] dig - [picture of a spade] wig - [picture of a wig]

- **Fill in the missing 'i' to finish the word:**

p _ g b _ g d _ g

- **Write the word 'big' and the word 'fig':**

big fig

- **Circle the word that matches the picture of a wig:**

wig pig dig

Self-check: Read your words out loud to Pip the bookworm to see if they sound right.
