

Sheet 6: The 'ph' Digraph

Worked example:

Say the sound of 'ph' in this word: dolphin.

Answer: dol-ph-in

phone photo dolphin graph

• Draw a line to match the word to the correct picture description:

phone: a device to call a friend photo: a picture of a memory dolphin: Finn swimming in the sea graph: a chart to show numbers
