

Sheet 6: Counting in 10s

Worked example:

Max counts his bananas in groups of 10: 10, 20, 30, 40.

Answer: The next number is 50.

- **Complete the sequence of 10s:**

10, 20, 30, ____, 50

- **Keep counting in 10s:**

50, 60, 70, ____, 90, 100

- **Max has 10p coins. Write the total amount for 3 coins:**

10p, 20p, ____

- **Write the missing numbers in the 10s pattern:**

10, ____, 30, 40, ____, 60

- **Count backwards from 100 in 10s:**

100, 90, 80, ____, 60

Self-check: Look at the tens digit in each number; it should go up by one each time (1, 2, 3...).

Ready for next: Once you can count in 10s to 100, you are ready to find 10 more and 10 less than any number.
