

Sheet 10: Subtracting Ones

Worked example:

Max has 28 acorns. He hides 4 acorns in a tree. How many are left? $28 - 4 = ?$

Answer: $28 - 4 = 24$

- **Max is counting his collection. Solve these subtraction puzzles:**

$$35 - 3 = 47 - 5 = 69 - 6 =$$

- **Help Max finish his sums:**

$$58 - 4 = 86 - 2 = 99 - 7 =$$

- **Max has £76. He spends £5 on a new toy. How much does he have left?**

$$£76 - £5 = £$$

Self-check: Look at the tens digit; it should stay the same, while the ones digit gets smaller.

Ready for next: Once you can subtract ones from 2-digit numbers, you are ready to start adding two 2-digit numbers together!
