- An adjective is a special word that describes a noun, like a person, place, or thing.
- You can use adjectives to talk about colours, such as bright red or deep blue.
- Adjectives can tell us about size, like big, small, tall, or tiny.
- Use adjectives to describe how something feels, such as smooth, bumpy, soft, or prickly.
- Adjectives help us describe how something tastes, like sweet, sour, or crunchy.
- If you are unsure if a word is an adjective, ask yourself: 'Does this word tell me more about the noun?'

Did you know? Did you know? Adjectives are like magic glasses! When you add them to a sentence, they help the reader see exactly what you are imagining in your head. Instead of just a 'caterpillar', you can describe a 'tiny, fuzzy, green caterpillar'!
