

Adjective Explorers with Max the Monkey

Learning objective: To identify and use adjectives to describe nouns in sentences.

Read the front of each flashcard to find a word or a challenge. Flip the card in your mind to reveal the answer. Use these cards to help Max the Monkey describe the items in his maths puzzles!

What is an adjective?	Is 'Max' an adjective or a noun?
An adjective is a word that describes a noun.	Max is a noun because it is the name of a person (or monkey).
Pick an adjective to describe this apple: The ____ apple.	Find the adjective in this sentence: The fluffy elephant walked home.
Possible answers: red, crunchy, shiny, small, sweet.	Fluffy.
Which of these words is an adjective? A) Banana B) Yellow C) Run	Add an adjective to describe the size of a mountain: The ____ mountain.
B) Yellow.	Possible answers: tall, huge, giant, enormous.
Find the two adjectives in this sentence: Pip the caterpillar ate a juicy, green leaf.	What is the noun in this sentence: The brave lion roared.
Juicy and green.	Lion.
Think of an adjective to describe how a cold ice cream feels.	Find the adjective in this sentence: Zara painted a bright picture.
Possible answers: cold, freezing, chilly.	Bright.
True or False: 'Soft' is an adjective.	Complete the phrase with a colour adjective: The ____ ocean.
True.	Possible answers: blue, deep, turquoise.
