

Adjective Adventure with Max the Monkey

Learning objective: To identify and use adjectives to describe nouns in a creative context.

Max the Monkey is exploring a magical jungle. Use your imagination to draw his surroundings. Once you have finished your drawing, use the words from the word bank to label your picture and write sentences describing what Max can see.

Draw: Draw a scene featuring Max the Monkey exploring a jungle. Include at least three of the following: a tall tree, a winding river, a strange flower, or a pile of golden fruit. Use as much detail as possible so you can describe your drawing using the adjectives provided in the word bank.



Label words: vibrant · gigantic · sparkling · fluffy · ancient · curious · emerald · misty

Steps:

1. Find an adjective in the word bank that describes the size of a tree. Write a sentence using that adjective to describe a tree in your drawing.
2. Label three parts of your drawing using adjectives from the word bank.
3. Why do we use adjectives when we are writing stories? Explain in one sentence.
4. Choose one object in your drawing and think of two different adjectives to describe it. Write them here.
5. Look at Max the Monkey in your drawing. Write an adjective that describes how he is feeling during his

adventure.
