

## Painting Pictures with Words: Using Adjectives

*Learning objective: To use expanded noun phrases and precise adjectives to add detail, interest, and clarity to writing.*

Today, you are going to write a descriptive paragraph about a magical garden. Use the word bank to help you choose exciting adjectives that describe the sights, sounds, and smells of your setting. Remember, good writers show, not just tell!

As I pushed open the creaky, iron gate, I stepped into a garden that seemed to hum with a secret life of its own.

**1. Describe the flowers in the garden. Use at least two adjectives to describe their colour and size. Start your sentence with: The flowers, which were... (2 marks)**

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**2. Describe the sound of the garden. How does the wind move through the leaves? Start your sentence with: A gentle breeze whispered through the... (2 marks)**

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**3. Nova the owl is watching from a tree. Describe the tree she is perched on using an expanded noun phrase. Start your sentence with: High above, Nova watched from her... (2 marks)**

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**4. What is the most mysterious object you can find in the garden? Use an adjective to describe it. Start your sentence with: Hidden beneath the ivy lay a... (2 marks)**

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**5. How do you feel as you walk through this place? Use a powerful adjective to describe your emotions. Start your sentence with: I felt entirely... (2 marks)**

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*Extension challenge: Choose two of your sentences and try to improve them by replacing your adjectives with even stronger, more precise synonyms. For example, change 'big' to 'colossal' or 'nice' to 'enchanted'.*
