Learning objective: To identify and use adverbs to modify verbs and enhance descriptive writing.

Read the passage carefully. Look for words that describe how actions are performed. Answer the questions in full sentences.

1. Find two adverbs from the text that describe how Max performed his tasks. (2 marks)

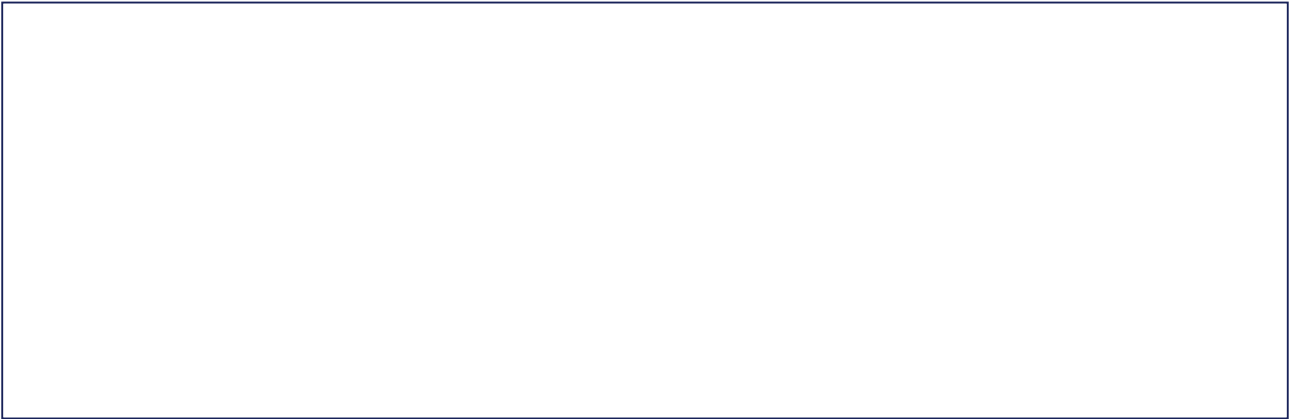
2. What was Max doing at the village market? (2 marks)
