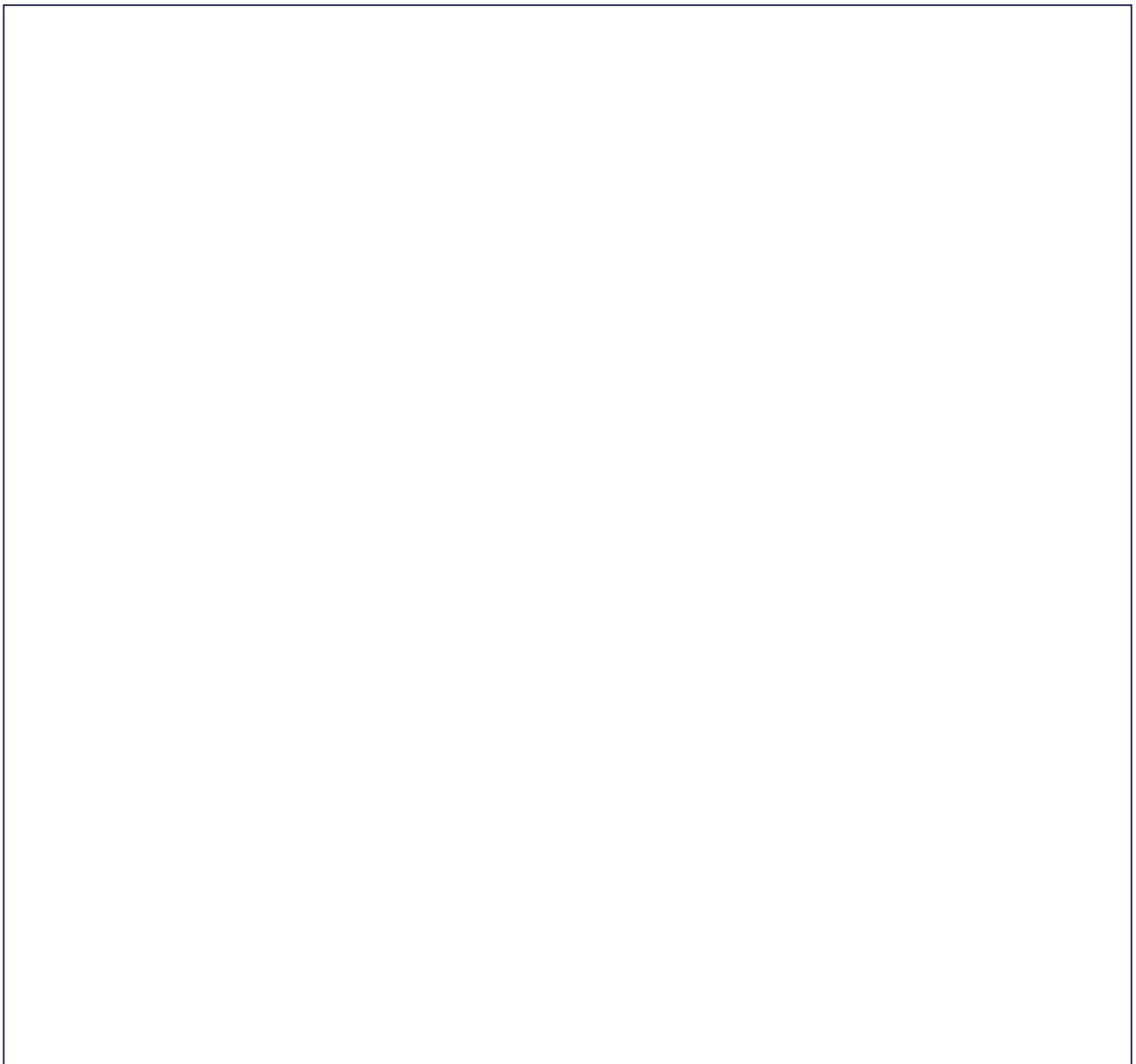


A Bright Night with Nova

Learning objective: To develop vocabulary related to Bonfire Night and practise labelling skills.

Read the facts about Bonfire Night with an adult. Colour in the picture of Nova the owl enjoying the fireworks display. Use your best colouring pencils to make the sparks shine bright! Label the fireworks and the scarf in the picture.

Colour this: A large, clear outline drawing of Nova the barn owl wearing a cosy, bobble-topped winter scarf. Nova is sitting on a sturdy tree branch looking up at the sky. In the sky, draw three large, star-shaped fireworks with thick outlines for children to colour. Below the branch, draw a small, safe pile of logs with flame shapes rising up. In the background, draw a gentle crescent moon. The lines should be bold and simple, suitable for a Class 1 student to colour within.



Steps:

1. Label the fireworks in your picture.
2. Label the scarf that Nova is wearing.
