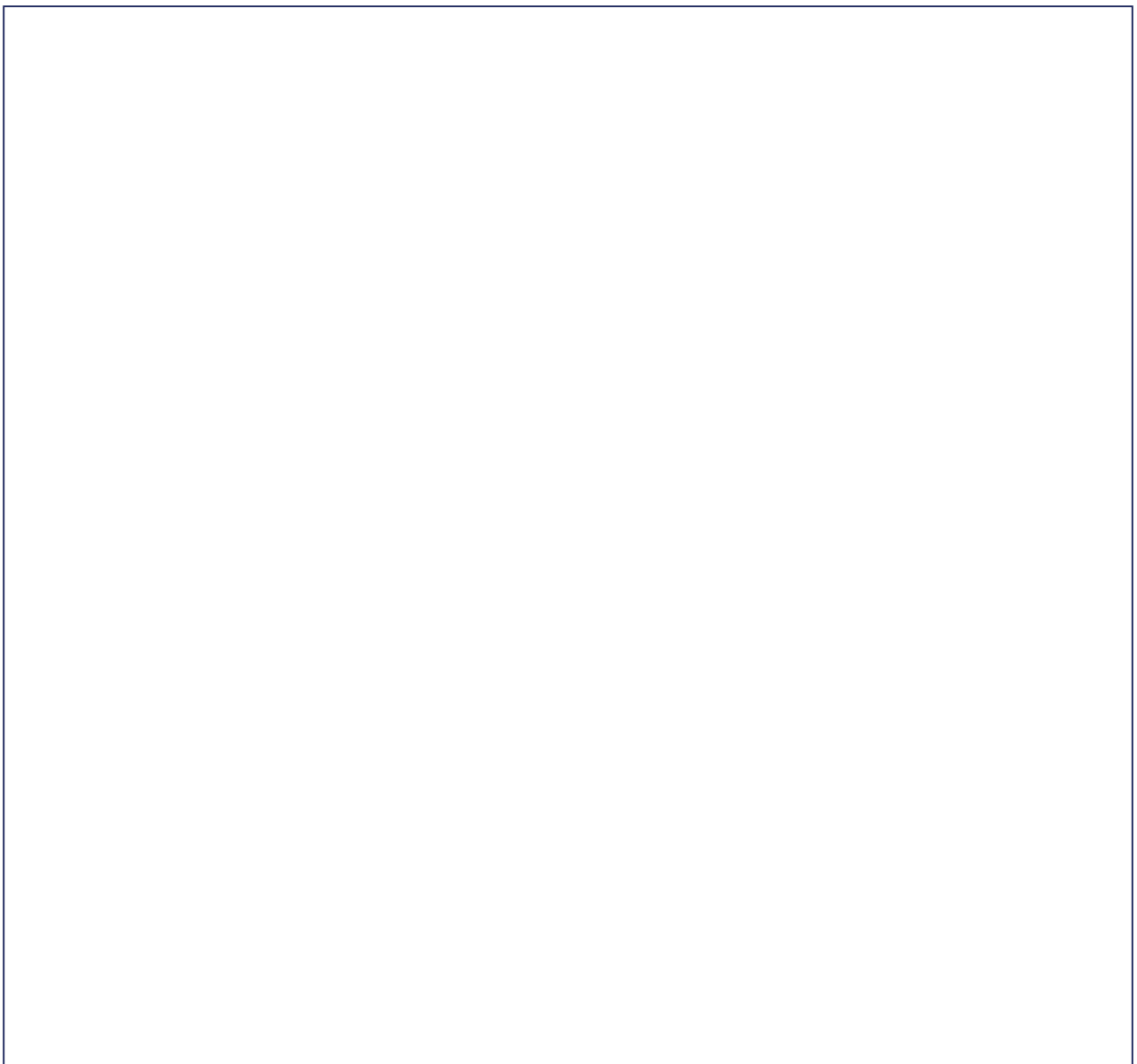


Nova's Bonfire Night Celebration

Learning objective: To develop fine motor skills through colouring and to build vocabulary related to seasonal celebrations.

Use your brightest crayons to colour in the scene. Think about the colours you see in a firework display! Once you have finished colouring, use your pencil to label the picture using the words provided in the box.
