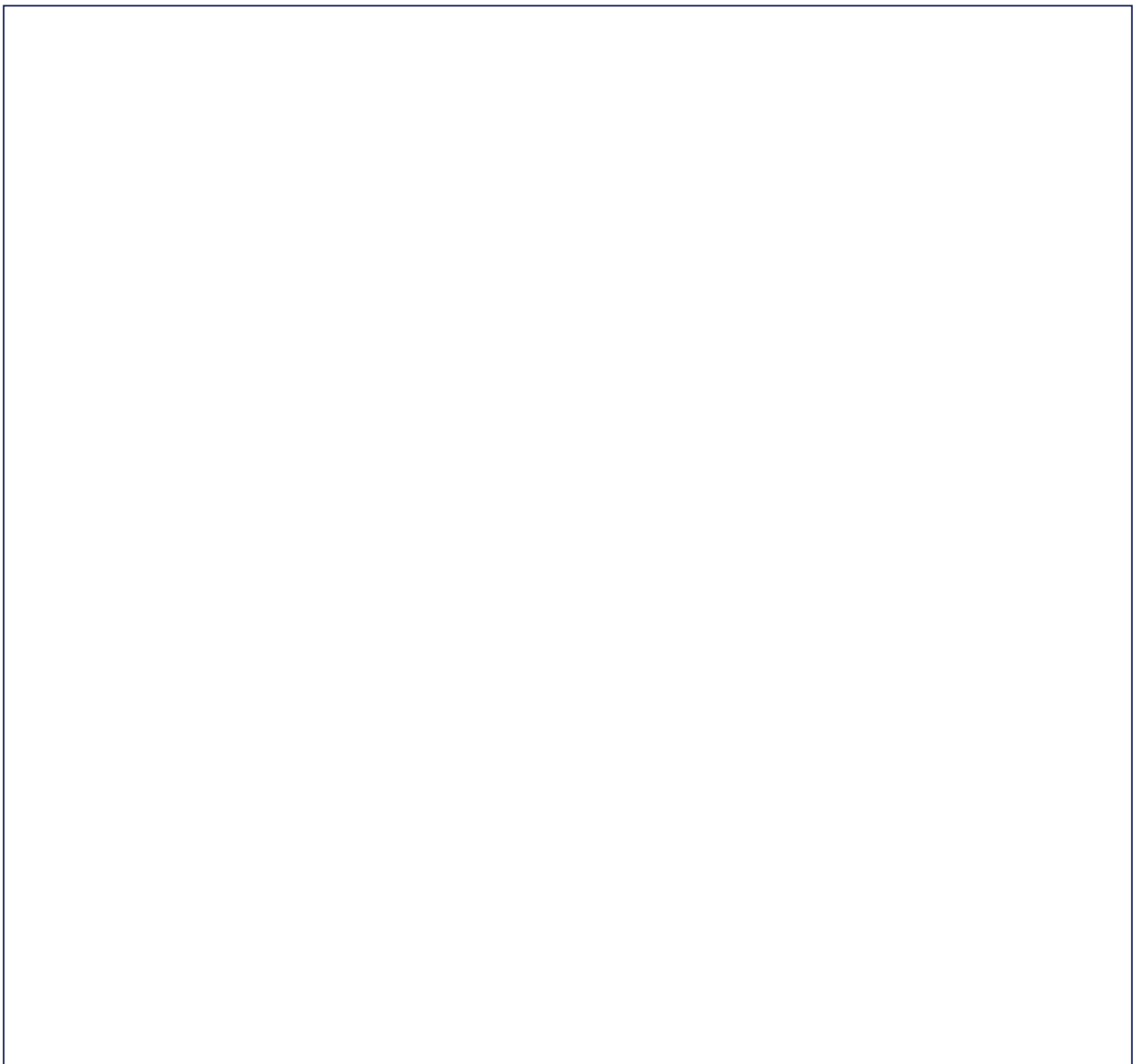


Pip's Book Review Corner

Learning objective: To understand the structure of a book review and express a personal opinion about a text.

Colour in the picture of Pip and his favourite book. Then, use the space provided to write your own short review of a book you have enjoyed reading recently.

Colour this: A friendly, smiling caterpillar named Pip wearing a tiny pair of glasses, sitting on a large, open book. Pip is holding a pencil. The book has a blank rectangular space on the cover for the child to write a title. Around Pip, there are floating stars, a small potted plant, and a bookshelf in the background. Use clear, bold outlines suitable for colouring. Provide a large, lined speech bubble or box next to Pip for the child to write their review.



Steps:

1. Label the title of the book in your picture.
