

My Book Review with Pip

Learning objective: To write a book review by expressing preferences and using descriptive language to explain why a book is enjoyable.

Help Pip the bookworm caterpillar share his latest read! Use this template to tell others about your favourite book. Think about the characters, the story, and what made you smile. Use the word bank to help you write super sentences.

Word bank: exciting · adventure · hilarious · interesting · favourite · character · surprising · wonderful · imaginative · recommended

1. Book Title and Author: Write the name of the book you read and the person who wrote it. (2 marks)

2. What is the story about?: Write a short summary of what happens in the book without spoiling the ending! (3 marks)

3. My Favourite Character: Who was your favourite character and why did you like them? (3 marks)

4. What I thought: Did you enjoy the book? Use an adjective from the word bank to describe how it made you feel. (2 marks)

5. Rating: If you could give this book a star rating out of 5, how many would you give it and why? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Imagine you are the main character in the book. Write one sentence in your best handwriting about what you would do next if the story continued!
