

My Favourite Storybook: A Review by You!

Learning objective: To express personal opinions about a book and use descriptive language to recommend it to others.

Think about a story you have recently enjoyed. Follow the drawing steps below to create a visual review, then use the word bank to help you write your thoughts in the space provided.

Draw: Draw a large, open book in the centre of your page. On the left page, draw your favourite scene from the story, including the main character. On the right page, draw your 'star rating' (out of five) and add a small speech bubble coming from the character saying one thing they learned or enjoyed. Use bright colours and clear outlines to make your scene jump off the page!



Label words: exciting · adventurous · favourite · character · illustration · setting · mysterious · wonderful

Steps:

1. Write the title of the book you have chosen and the name of the author.
2. Who is your favourite character in the story and why do you like them?
3. Describe the setting of the story. Where and when does it take place?
4. If you had to rate this book out of five stars, how many would you give it? Explain your choice.
5. Write one sentence to recommend this book to a friend. Use a word from the word bank.
