

Max the Monkey's Magical Market

Learning objective: To use descriptive language to write a short story based on a drawing.

Help Max the monkey at his market stall! Draw the items he is selling, then answer the questions to describe your scene.

Draw: Draw a large wooden market stall in the middle of a forest. On the table, draw at least three different types of fruit. Make sure to draw Max the monkey standing behind the stall wearing a little apron. Add a chalkboard sign near Max that shows the price of the fruit using the £ symbol. Use bright colours for the fruit and a brown colour for the wooden stall.



Label words: shiny · juicy · delicious · bright · bumpy · crunchy · expensive · cheap

Steps:

1. Look at your drawing. What is the most expensive item on Max's stall? Write its name and price in pounds.
2. Use an adjective from the word bank to describe one of the fruits you drew.
3. If Max sells a bunch of bananas for £2, and a customer gives him a £5 note, how much change should he give back?
4. Write a sentence about what happens next at the market.
