

Max's Magical Market Adventure

Learning objective: To use adjectives and descriptive language to write a short story.

Read the story about Max the monkey visiting the market. Use the word bank to help you complete the sentences and write your own creative ending.

Max the monkey skipped to the village market. He had £5 to spend. He saw a pile of apples that were round and red. Next, he found a basket of lemons that were sour and yellow. Max felt very excited. He bought a bunch of grapes that were dark purple. He counted his coins carefully. He had some money left over for a special treat.

Word bank: bumpy · shiny · sweet · bright · tasty · golden

1. Max saw apples that were round and red. Can you name one other fruit from the story and describe its colour? (2 marks)

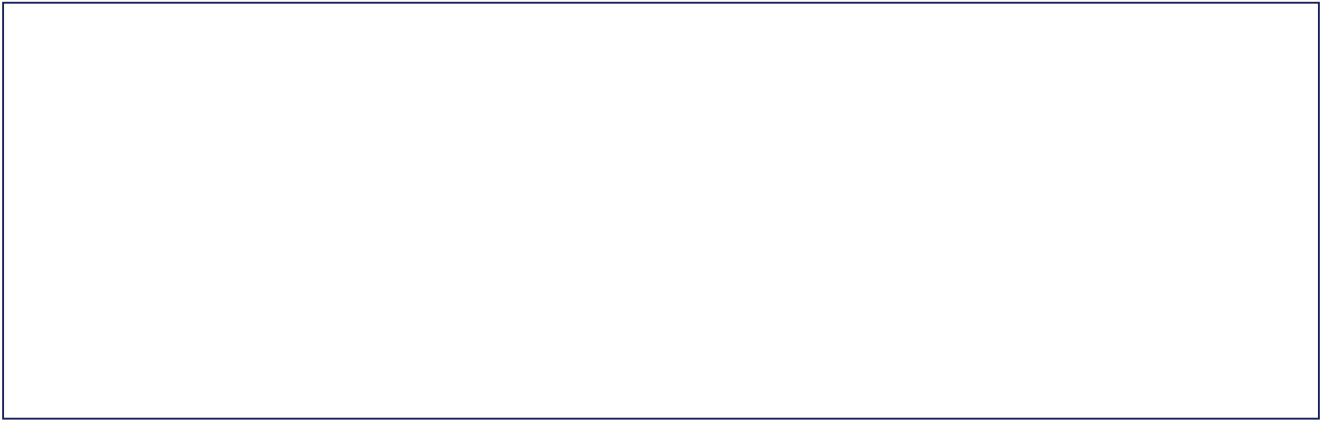
2. How much money did Max have to spend at the market? (1 mark)

3. Choose two words from the word bank to describe the fruit Max bought. (2 marks)

4. If Max had £1 left, what treat could he buy? Write a sentence about it. (2 marks)

5. Max felt excited. Why do you think Max was happy to be at the market? (2 marks)

Draw: Draw Max the monkey holding his basket of fruit at the market. Make sure to draw the fruit you described in your answers!



Extension challenge: Write two sentences about what Max did when he got home with his basket of fruit. Try to use at least one adjective from the word bank.
