1. Max found a _____ apple at the stall. (Choose an adjective to describe the apple's texture) (1 mark)

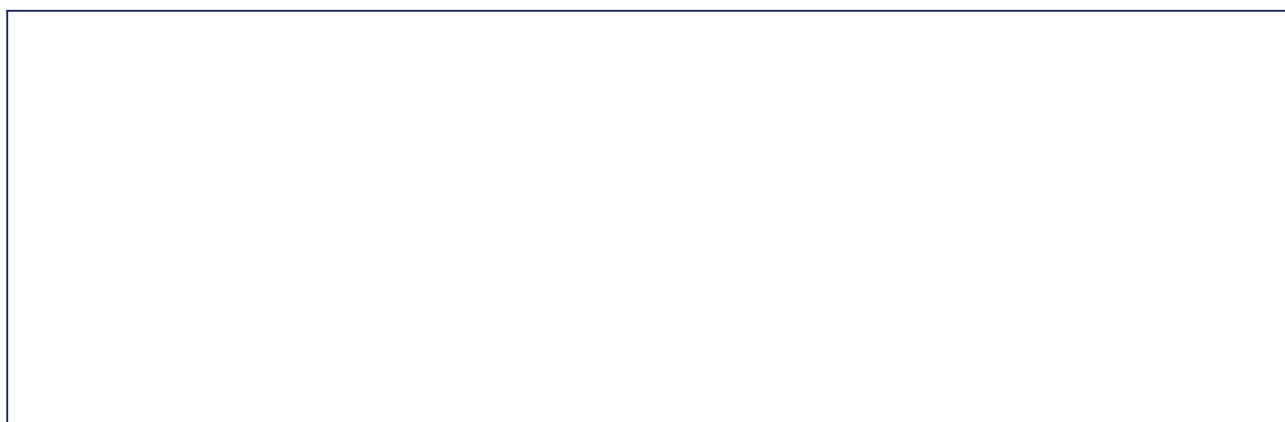
2. He bought a bunch of _____ grapes that looked like little jewels in the sun. (1 mark)
