

Pip the Story-Weaver's Garden

Learning objective: To use descriptive language and creative vocabulary to enhance a story setting.

Colour in the scene below and use your imagination to bring the story-garden to life! Add labels to the items Pip is using to write a new adventure.

Colour this: A large, friendly caterpillar named Pip wearing a tiny waistcoat and glasses, sitting on a giant, curled-up green leaf. Pip is holding a large feather quill pen. In front of Pip is an open, blank notebook resting on a mushroom. Around the scene, draw three large, colourful flowers with swirling patterns on the petals, a stack of three thick books nearby, and a small watering can. Use bold, clear outlines for colouring.
