

Create Your Own Character Profile with Max the Monkey

Learning objective: To use adjectives and descriptive language to build a unique character for a story.

Max the Monkey loves maths, but he also loves stories! To write a great story, you need a great character. Use this template to invent someone new. Think about how they look, what they like to do, and what makes them special. Be as creative as you can!

Word bank: adventurous · brave · cheerful · clumsy · enormous · giggling · mysterious · polite · shimmering · tiny

1. Character Name and Appearance: What is your character's name? Describe what they look like using exciting adjectives. (2 marks)

2. Special Skills: What is your character brilliant at doing? Do they have a secret talent? (2 marks)

3. Favourite Things: What does your character love to eat or collect? Where do they like to spend their time? (2 marks)

4. A Personality Clue: If your character found a £5 note on the ground, what would they choose to do with it? (2 marks)

5. The Big Adventure: If your character went on an adventure today, where would they go and who would they take with them? (3 marks)

Extension challenge: Now that you have created your character, write two sentences about a problem they might face in a story, and how they would solve it using their special skill.
