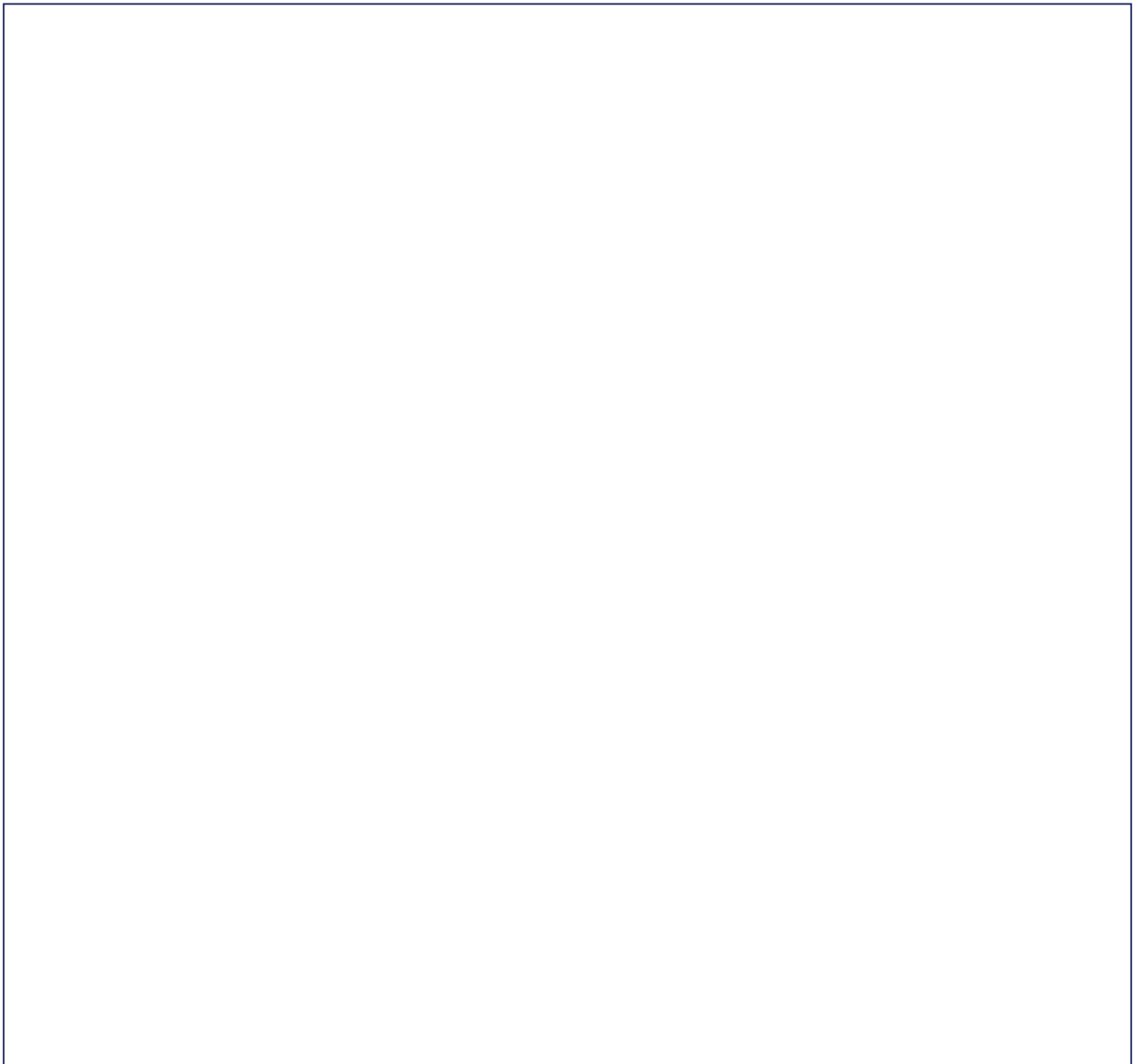


Springtime with Pip the Bookworm

Learning objective: To learn about the history and traditions of Easter through creative colouring and labelling.

Colour in the picture of Pip the Bookworm celebrating spring. Use your best colours to make the scene bright and cheery. Then, complete the labelling activity below to show what you know!

Colour this: A large, friendly, smiling caterpillar named Pip wearing a tiny sun hat. Pip is sitting on a large, smooth green leaf. Next to Pip is a large, decorated Easter egg with patterns like stripes and zig-zags on it. In the background, there is a tall daffodil flower with long petals and a trumpet-shaped centre. Steps:
