Learning objective: To understand and sequence the key events of the Easter story by placing them in the correct chronological order.

Ellie the Elephant has been reading stories about springtime traditions and the Easter story. She has mixed up the order of events! Look at the list of sentences below. Use your pencil to write the numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 in the circles to show what happened first, second, third, fourth, and fifth in the story.

1. O) The friends share a special meal together. (1 mark)

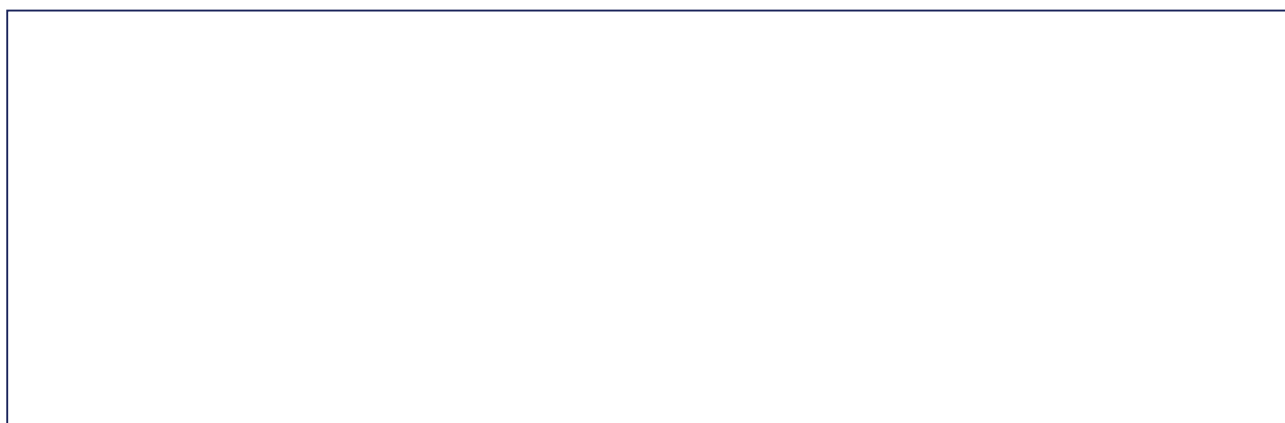
2. O) A new day begins and the garden is full of light. (1 mark)
