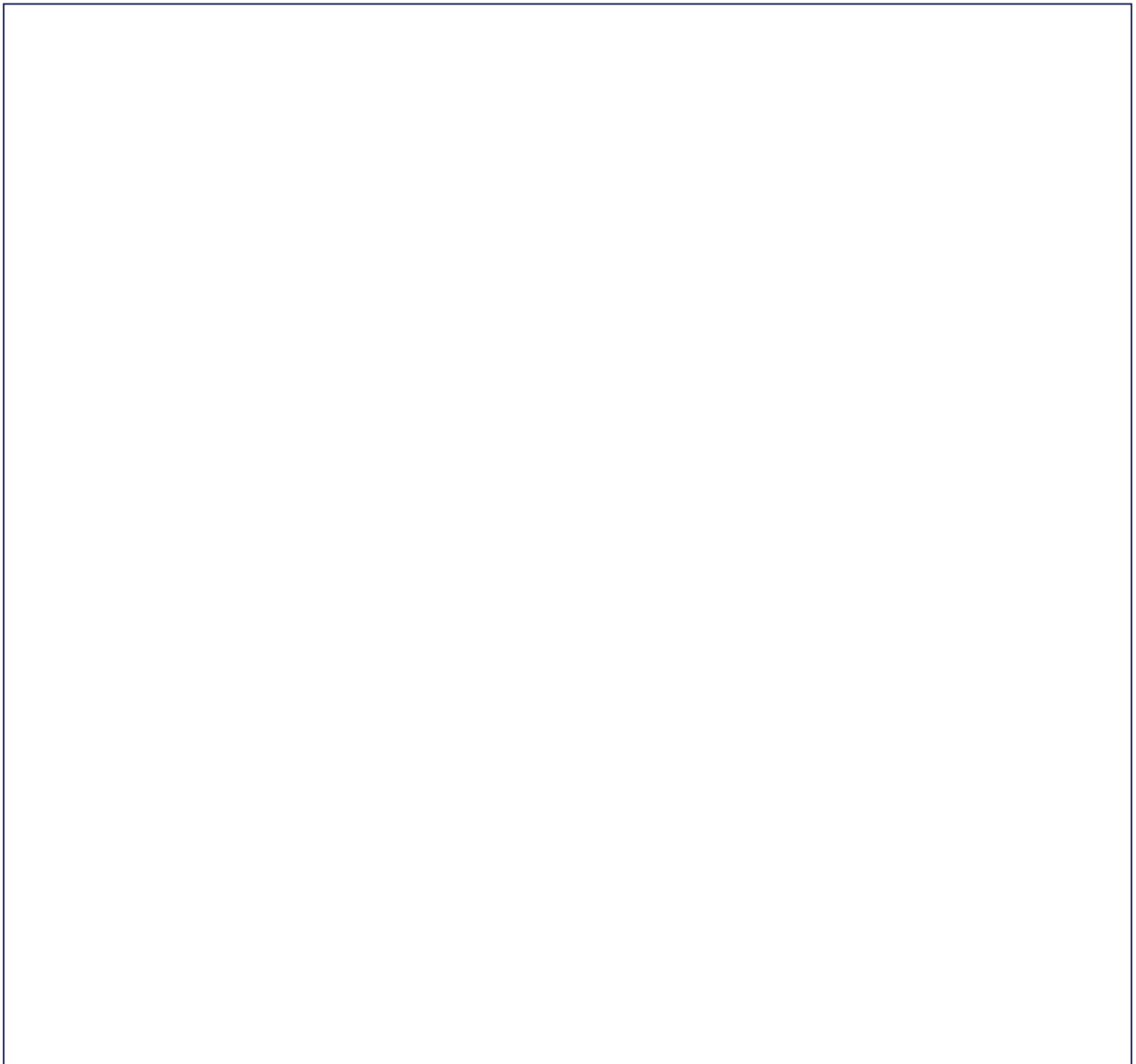


Pip's Easter Garden Celebration

Learning objective: To develop fine motor skills through colouring and to recognise features of the Easter season.

Use your favourite colouring pencils or crayons to bring this garden scene to life. Think about the colours of spring flowers and the bright patterns on the Easter eggs.

Colour this: A friendly caterpillar named Pip is sitting on a large, smooth garden stone. Beside Pip, there are three large, decorated Easter eggs with different patterns: one with wavy lines, one with polka dots, and one with stars. In the background, there is a tall, bright daffodil flower and a small, fluffy cloud in the sky. The lines should be bold and clear for a 3-5 year old to colour within.



Steps:

1. Label the flower in your picture.
2. Label the egg in your picture.
