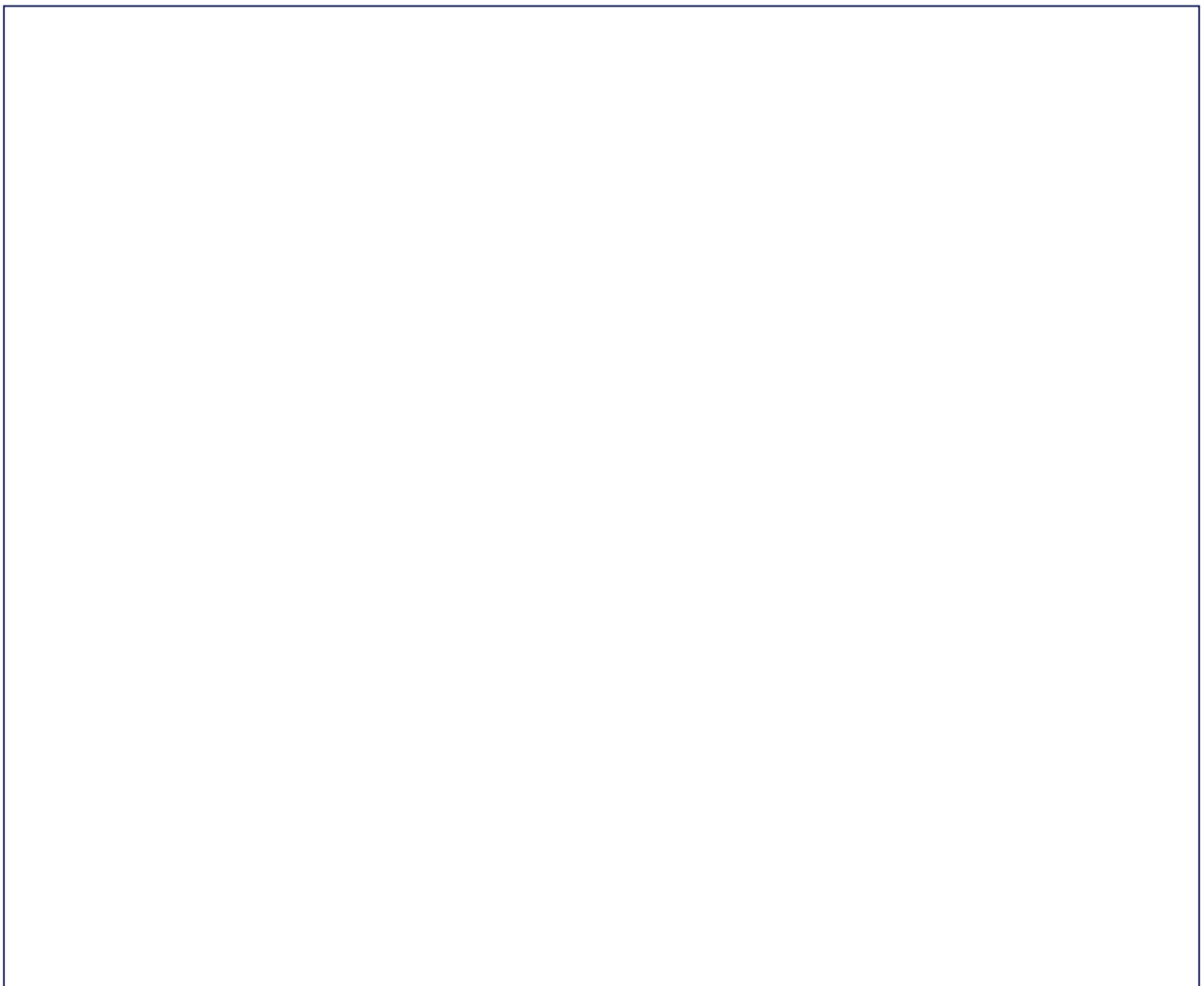


Pip's Easter Garden Adventure

Learning objective: To develop fine motor skills and spatial awareness by drawing and labelling a sequence of events related to springtime and new life.

Pip the caterpillar is busy getting the garden ready for spring! Look at the word bank and draw the items in your garden scene. Use your best colouring pencils to make your garden bright and cheerful.

Draw: Create a large, colourful garden scene. In the centre, draw a comfortable nest hidden amongst tall blades of grass. Add a bright, smiling sun in the corner of the sky. Include a small, friendly caterpillar (Pip) near a patch of newly bloomed flowers. Use soft, spring-like colours such as yellows, greens, and pinks. Ensure there is plenty of white space for the child to add their own details.



Label words: egg · flower · sun · nest · grass · caterpillar

Steps:

1. Draw a bright yellow sun in the sky and a green flower in the garden.
2. Draw a small nest with an egg inside it. How many eggs can you fit?
3. Draw Pip the caterpillar sitting on a leaf near the grass.
4. Label your drawing using words from the word bank.
5. If a pack of flower seeds costs £1, and you buy two packs, how much money do you spend?
