Learning objective: To recall key events from the Easter story and express personal reflections using descriptive language.

Help Ellie the Elephant remember the story of Easter! Read the story with your teacher, then use this template to record what you have learned. Write or draw your answers in the boxes provided to show your understanding.

1. The Beginning: Who are the main people in the story and where are they? (2 marks)

2. The Big Event: What is the most important thing that happens in the middle of the story? (2 marks)

3. Feeling Kind: How do the characters show kindness to one another? (2 marks)

4. The Ending: What happens at the end that makes the characters feel happy? (2 marks)

5. My Special Thought: If you could give a gift to a friend at Easter, what would it be and why? (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Imagine you are planning an Easter party. If a small chocolate egg costs £1, how much would it cost to buy 3 eggs for your friends? Draw a picture of your party table.
