- A full stop is a tiny dot that tells the reader to stop and take a breath. It goes at the end of your sentence.
- A noun is a naming word. It can be a person, a place, or a thing, like 'Max', 'park', or 'banana'.
- A verb is an action word. It tells us what someone or something is doing, like 'jump', 'eat', or 'run'.
- A conjunction is a joining word. We use 'and', 'but', or 'because' to make our sentences longer and more exciting.
- Check your work: Does your sentence make sense? Does it have a capital letter at the start and a full stop at the end?
