

Max's Grammar Adventure: Describing My Day

Learning objective: To use expanded noun phrases and adjectives to add detail to writing.

Help Max the monkey organise his day! Use the sections below to describe your morning routine. Remember to use expanded noun phrases (adjectives + noun) to make your writing more descriptive. For example, instead of 'the banana', write 'the delicious, yellow banana'.

Word bank: enormous · sparkling · cheerful · tasty · mysterious · bumpy · gentle · bright · quickly · carefully

1. The Breakfast Scene: Describe what you ate for breakfast using at least two adjectives to describe your food. (2 marks)

2. The Journey to School: Describe the path you took to school. Was the road bumpy? Was the sky bright? (2 marks)

3. The Classroom Puzzle: Max loves maths! Write a sentence about a tricky puzzle you solved today, using an adverb to describe how you worked. (2 marks)

4. The Playground Fun: Describe a game you played with your friends. Use an expanded noun phrase to describe the equipment you used. (3 marks)

5. The Reflection: Why is it important to use adjectives in your writing? Explain your answer to Max. (2 marks)

Extension challenge: Choose one of your sentences above and try to improve it by adding a prepositional phrase (e.g., 'under the tree', 'beside the colourful bag').
