3. 3. Nova the owl is sitting alone. She has a tear on her cheek and her feathers are drooping. How does Nova feel? (One word answer) (1 mark)

4. 4. Max sees Ellie the elephant holding an umbrella and wearing her yellow wellies. What is happening? A) It is sunny B) It is lunchtime C) It is raining D) It is bedtime (1 mark)

5. 5. True or False: If Leo the lion is yawning and stretching, we can infer he is ready to run a fast race. (1 mark)

6. 6. Bea the bee is buzzing quickly from flower to flower with a big grin on her face. How does Bea feel? (One word answer) (1 mark)

7. 7. Kit the fox is looking at a map and scratching his head. What is he doing? A) Trying to find his way B) Sleeping C) Eating lunch D) Dancing (1 mark)

8. 8. True or False: If a character is shivering and wrapping a scarf around their neck, we can infer they are cold. (1 mark)

9. 9. Rosa the parrot is pacing back and forth and biting her lip. How does Rosa feel? (One word answer) (1 mark)

10. 10. Finn the dolphin is jumping high out of the water and splashing his friends. How are the friends likely feeling? A) Grumpy B) Happy C) Scared D) Hungry (1 mark)
