Learning objective: To understand the features of instructional writing, including bossy verbs, time connectives, and chronological order.

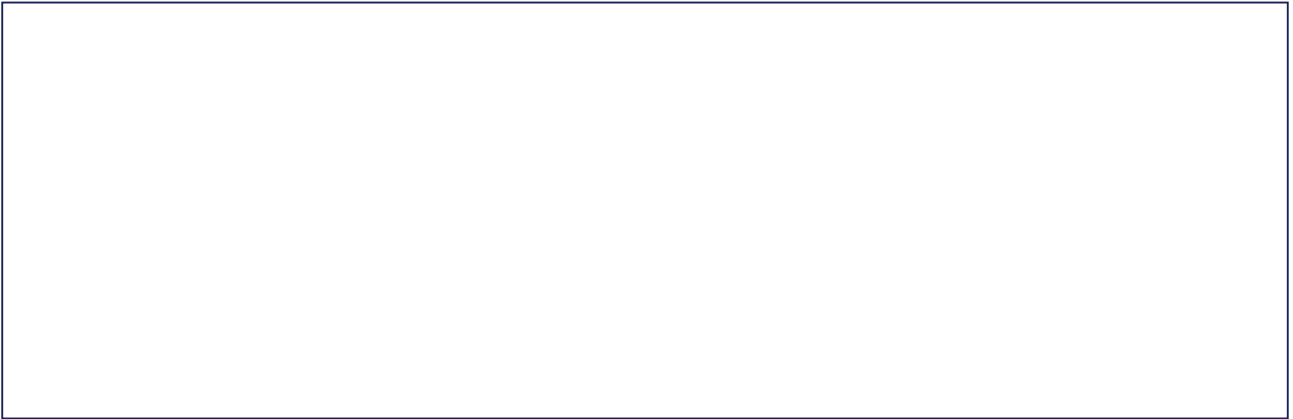
