

Max the Monkey's Action Adventure

Learning objective: To identify and use nouns and verbs within a sentence to describe a scene.

Max the Monkey is exploring the jungle! Look at the word bank to help you. Write a noun (a person, place, or thing) to name what you see, and a verb (an action word) to describe what is happening in your scene. Remember: a noun is a naming word, and a verb is a doing word.

Word bank: monkey · climb · banana · swing · tree · jump · leaf · run · jungle · eat

1. My Noun: Write down a noun from the word bank to name a thing you might find in the jungle. (2 marks)

2. My Verb: Write down a verb from the word bank to describe an action Max the Monkey could do. (2 marks)

3. The Sentence: Write a short sentence using one noun and one verb from the list above. (3 marks)

4. Spot the Noun: Look at your sentence. Draw a circle around the noun you used. (1 mark)

5. Spot the Verb: Look at your sentence. Underline the verb you used. (1 mark)

Extension challenge: Can you think of one more noun and one more verb that are not in the word bank? Write them down and use them in a new sentence!
