

Pip's Phonic Adventure: Digraph Discovery

Learning objective: To identify and read common consonant digraphs (sh, ch, th, ng, ai, ee, igh, oa) in words.

Read the front of each card to identify the sound. Flip the card mentally (or check the answer) to see a word that uses that sound. Can you think of another word that uses the same sound?

What sound does the digraph 'sh' make?

sh as in ship

What sound does the digraph 'ch' make?

ch as in chat

What sound does the digraph 'th' make?

th as in thin

What sound does the digraph 'ng' make?

ng as in song

What sound does the digraph 'ai' make?

ai as in rain

What sound does the digraph 'ee' make?

ee as in tree

What sound does the trigraph 'igh' make?

igh as in light

What sound does the digraph 'oa' make?

oa as in boat

Can you spot the digraph in the word 'fish'?

sh

Can you spot the digraph in the word 'maths'?

th
