

# Pip's Phonics Garden: Working with Digraphs

*Learning objective: To identify and use the 'sh', 'ch', 'th', and 'ng' digraphs in words.*

Help Pip the bookworm caterpillar sort his garden words. Use the word bank to fill in the gaps and tick the correct boxes.

*Word bank: chip · shop · thin · song · bath · fish · chin · wing*

**1. Pip found a shiny object. Which word from the bank starts with 'sh' and ends with 'p'? (1 mark)**

**2. Max the monkey is eating a potato \_\_\_\_\_. Write the word from the bank that has the 'ch' sound. (1 mark)**

**3. Look at the word 'thin'. Can you write two other words from the bank that contain a digraph? (2 marks)**

**4. If you take the word 'song' and change 's' to 'wi', what new word do you get? (1 mark)**

**5. Choose one word from the bank and write a full sentence using it. Remember your capital letter and full stop. (2 marks)**

**Draw:** Draw a picture of Pip the caterpillar sitting in a garden. In the speech bubble above Pip, draw three things that have the 'sh' sound in their name, like a fish or a shell.



*Extension challenge: Can you find a word in your house that has a 'th' sound? Write it down and show it to your teacher tomorrow!*
