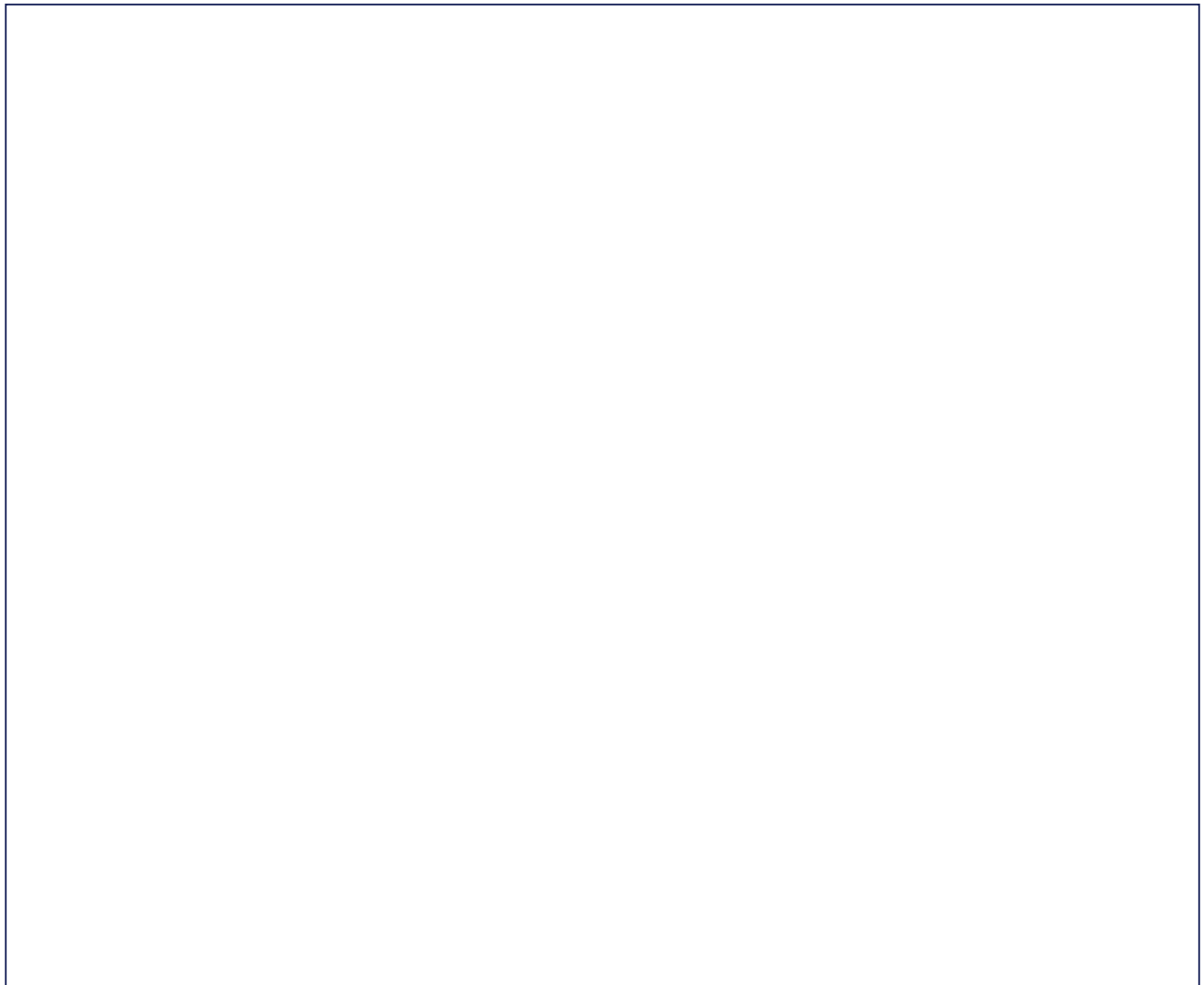


Leo the Lion's Poetry Garden

Learning objective: To use descriptive language and adjectives to visualise a scene for a poem.

Leo the Lion is writing a poem about his favourite place in the forest. Read the words in the word bank and draw them into the scene. Think about what colours and shapes you will use to make the garden look magical.

Draw: Draw a sunny, vibrant garden scene. Include Leo the Lion sitting in the centre. Fill the space with tall, colourful flowers, soft green grass, and sparkles in the air to show the 'breezy' feeling. Use bright, cheerful colours to make the scene look like a happy poem.



Label words: sunshine · golden · sparkly · tall · whispering · soft · breezy

Steps:

1. Step 1: Draw a large, golden sun in the top corner of your page. How does it make the garden feel?
2. Step 2: Draw some tall flowers. Label one flower with an adjective from the word bank.
3. Step 3: Draw Leo the Lion sitting in the grass. What is he holding in his paw?
4. Step 4: Draw something 'sparkly' near the flowers. What did you choose to draw?
5. Step 5: Write one sentence describing your garden using at least two words from the word bank.
